



# STORY STONES



## WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Pebbles, Paints / Sharpies and Paper

1. Give each pebble a facial feature, we went with a handful of emotions that are easy to draw! The simpler the better. If you have saplings in your house let them help you!
2. Now draw a blank face on a piece of paper
3. Take it in turns to build faces with the story stones, open up the conversation to what emotions they can see, what that would make us feel and how we act when we are feeling that way.
4. Let their creativity run wild, create story boards on the paper and uses the story stones to help add emotion into the story!

This is a great activity to open the discussion on emotions and hopefully create a better understanding between how they feel and their actions.

Top tip - Keep the stones around and if your little ones are struggling to tell you how they feel you can get them to show you!
